Steve Collier has been a lifelong resident of Lawrence. He attended Harrison Hill Elementary, Belzer Junior High, and is a 1973 graduate of Lawrence Central High School. Upon graduating from Hanover College in 1977, Mayor Collier returned to teach and coach at Lawrence North High School. Primarily teaching United States History throughout his career, he initiated LN's Advanced

Placement US History program. He coached football, wrestling, and baseball for the Wildcats and served as Dean of Students, Head Football Coach, and Athletic Director during his 33 year tenure. He and his wife, Chris, (who taught for 27 years at Harrison Hill) saw both of their children attend and graduate from Lawrence Township Schools.

Following his career in education, Steve served on Lawrence's Common Council for the 5th District from 2012-2015. Elected Mayor in November of 2015, he became the seventh Mayor to serve the citizens of Lawrence. In his first term, Mayor Collier has demonstrated his continued commitment to public safety and quality economic development. Notably, the Mayor is very proud of the solid partnership developed between the City of Lawrence and Lawrence Township Schools.
