CARES Act Stimulates Giving to Nonprofits

For 2020 there is a new universal charitable deduction. A reduction in taxable income is available for donors who do not itemize their deductions, i.e., an "above-the-line" adjustment to income that will reduce a donor's Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) and consequently taxable income. The adjustment is available for cash gifts up to \$300 per taxpayer or \$600 for a married couple.
