

## 2023-24 SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION Lawrence North High School

Applications will be available at <u>www.msdltf.org</u> December 6, 2023 - February 4, 2024

**Sandy Bartenbach Memorial Scholarship:** \$500 scholarship awarded to an MSDLT high school senior who is a former Crestview Elementary student, is attending a two or four year college, university, or trade school, and has demonstrated high character. Requires 1 Reference.

**Dwaine C. Bell Memorial Scholarship:** \$500 scholarship awarded to a senior boy and a senior girl from each MSDLT high school. This scholarship does not go through an application process. *Selections are made by the Athletic Director at each high school*.

**Peggy Bender Legacy Scholarship:** \$1,000 scholarship awarded to an MSDLT high school senior who attended MCIT and who has overcome obstacles, demonstrates kindness to others, is helpful and generous, has a positive attitude, and exhibits the seven character attributes of National Technical Honor Society: Skill, Honesty, Service, Responsibility, Scholarship, Citizenship, and Leadership. Special consideration will be given to current NTHS members in good standing. Requires 1 Reference.

**Bridge Fund AVID Scholarship:** \$1,000 plus a laptop awarded to a senior at each MSDLT high school who is actively involved in the AVID program and demonstrates a degree of financial need. Requires 1 Reference.

**Cohron's Manufactured Homes Scholarship:** \$750 or higher scholarship awarded to an MSDLT high school senior who resides in a Cohron Manufactured Homes Community and has a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher. Requires 1 Reference.

**Richard H. Crosser Memorial Scholarship:** \$500 to \$1,500 scholarships are awarded to at least one MSDLT high school senior whose intended major supports the building trades (accounting, engineering, business management, interior design, etc.), is attending a two or four year Indiana college or university, is ranked in the top third of the class, and is involved in a variety of activities. Requires 1 Reference.

**FitzGibbon Scholarship:** \$1,000-\$2,000 scholarship awarded to an MSDLT high school senior who is attending an out-of-state college or university, is receiving an Honors or IB diploma, and has a GPA of 3.75 or above. Requires 1 Reference.

**Linda Greenlee Legacy Scholarship:** \$2,000 scholarship awarded to a Lawrence Central or Lawrence North senior who is planning to study education and become a teacher, is attending an Indiana college or university, and is in good academic standing. Requires 1 Reference.

**Lauren Hanawalt Scholarship**: \$4,000 scholarship awarded to a senior at Lawrence North High School who is planning to attend a college or trade school, and who demonstrates compassion for others and a love of life. Requires 1 Reference.

**Ronald Klene Scholarship**: \$1,000 scholarship awarded to a senior at Lawrence North High School who is currently enrolled in or has completed the AP Government class. Requires 1 Reference.

**Lawrence Advance Academy Scholarship:** \$500 scholarship awarded to an MSDLT high school senior who attended the Lawrence Advance Academy, has a GPA of 2.25 or higher, and had a 90% or higher attendance rate while at LAA. Requires 1 Reference.

**Lawrence Township Basketball League Scholarship:** \$500-\$1,000 scholarship awarded to a senior at each MSDLT high school. Applicants must have participated in the Lawrence Township Basketball League, have a 2.5 minimum GPA, are attending a four year college, and have made a contribution back to youth in sports in some capacity. Requires 2 References.

**Ed Martin Legacy Fund Scholarship:** \$1,500 scholarship awarded to an MSDLT high school senior who has been accepted to an Automotive Technology Institute. The winner of this scholarship will be offered an internship at an Ed Martin Automotive dealership. Requires 1 Reference.

**Michael J. and Alisa A. McGlothlin Scholarship Fund:** Scholarship for tuition and books for one year, averaging \$10,000, awarded to a Lawrence North senior who served as a varsity team student manager during his/her junior and senior years and has a GPA of 2.7 or higher. Requires 1 Reference from current coach.

**Richard Phillipy Scholarship for Study Abroad:** \$1,000 scholarship awarded to an MSDLT high school student or alum to study abroad. Travel must be completed by May 2024. Requires 1 Reference.

**Debra Porterfield Legacy Scholarship:** \$500 scholarship awarded to an MSDLT high school senior who is planning to study Culinary Arts. Preference will be given to MCIT students. Requires 1 Reference.

**Edger C. Seitz/Scott A. Seitz Endowed Scholarship:** \$500 to \$1,500 scholarships are awarded to at least one MSDLT high school senior who is majoring in a healthcare-related field, is ranked in the top third of her/his class, participated in school, community, or service activities, and shows a degree of financial need. Requires 1 Reference.

**Spanish Immersion Scholarship:** \$500 scholarship for a Lawrence North senior in the Spanish Immersion Program who is going to use the Spanish Language in her/his career. Requires 1 Reference.

**John H. Stewart, Ill Foundation Scholarship:** \$1,000 scholarship for a Lawrence North senior who has achieved academic excellence and shows concern for others, especially disadvantaged children, and demonstrates a degree of financial need. Requires 1 Reference.

**DJ Tamer Memorial Scholarship:** \$2,000 awarded to a Lawrence North senior, who has lettered in at least one varsity sport, and is academically high achieving. AN INTERVIEW MAY BE REQUIRED FOR THE TOP FINALISTS. Requires 2 References.

**Kristan Leah Wilson Scholarship:** \$1,000 scholarship for an MSDLT senior girl who is attending a two or four year college or university, is majoring in a healthcare or social services-related field, is ranked in the top 25% of her class, is a female athlete who has lettered in a varsity sport, and has demonstrated leadership and involvement in extracurricular activities. Requires 2 References.
