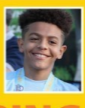

CARES Act Stimulates Giving to Nonprofits

As widely known, the Federal Government passed the CARES Act to help provide financial resources to our citizens and communities during these difficult times. Did you know that the CARES Act has some [tax reduction incentives for Charitable Giving](#)? With the recent changes in the tax code, many people are no longer "itemizing" and are instead using the "standard deduction." The CARES Act provides a way for donors who do not itemize to give \$300 (\$600 for a married couple) to a public charity and apply this donation as an adjustment to their Adjusted Gross Income on their 2020 tax return.

If you want to take advantage of the \$300/\$600 tax reduction incentive under the CARES Act for people who do not itemize, please consider making a donation to the [LTSF Cares Fund](#).
